Adults with Disabilities

The Adults with Disabilities Program is for persons over the age of seventeen (17) with a clinical diagnosis of a physical disability. Socialization with other adults is provided as well as opportunities to develop, maintain, or increase work, social, and daily living skills. The overall goal is to move the individual toward increased independence. Funding is provided by Hamilton County Social Services and the United Way of Greater Chattanooga.

Eligibility Information:

- Must be 17 years of age or older
- Must have received a primary clinical diagnosis of having a physical disability
- Must complete application process



Geriatric Services

The Geriatric Day Services Program is designed to assist low-income individuals over the age of sixty (60) in maintaining their independence, thereby increasing the chance of remaining within their own home for as long as possible. The Program allows caregivers to continue with a normal work schedule with the understanding that their loved one is in a safe and comfortable environment during the day.

Eligibility Information:

- Must be at least 60 years of age
- Must meet State of Tennessee income guidelines
- Must complete application process

Serving Chattanooga since 1978

Since 1978, both of the Programs of the Adult Center have provided Social Models of service with a shared goal of prevention of depression and provision of peer interaction. All activities and therapies are designed to activate or motivate participants to maximize their functional capacity.

Activities include arts and crafts, age-appropriate games, daily living skills, music therapy, pet therapy, and skills building in the areas of health, nutrition, and money management. Additionally, there are trips to local points of interest, picnics, and shopping.
